Admission Decision and Notification

- Complete applications are reviewed on a rolling basis each semester. The admissions committee begins reviewing completed applications upon receipt and finalizes all admission decisions prior to the beginning of classes. Applicants will be notified, in writing, of their admission, rejection, or wait-list status as soon as the decision is final.
